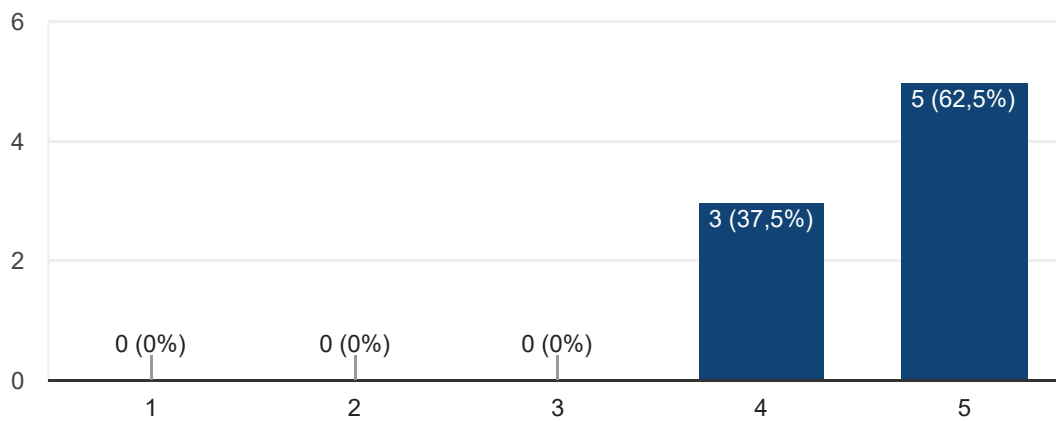

I know that there were constructionwork in your building, therefore the meetingroom couldn't be perfect! Temperature was low, no heating. It influences me!

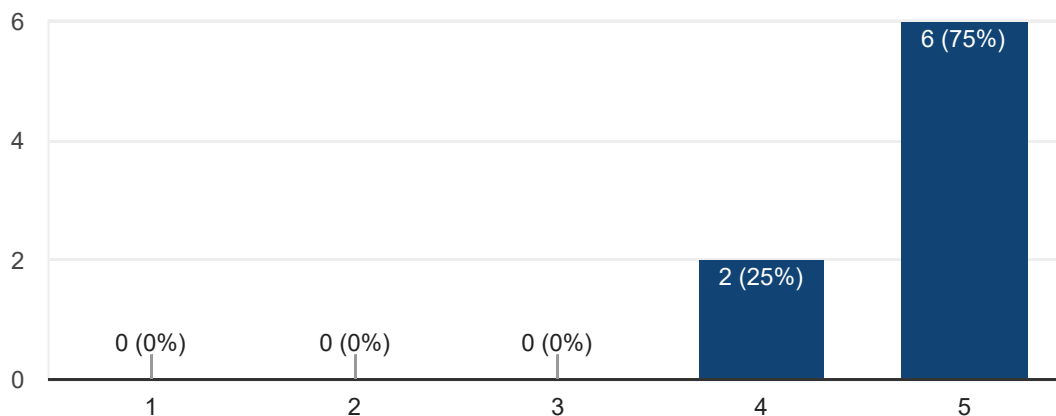

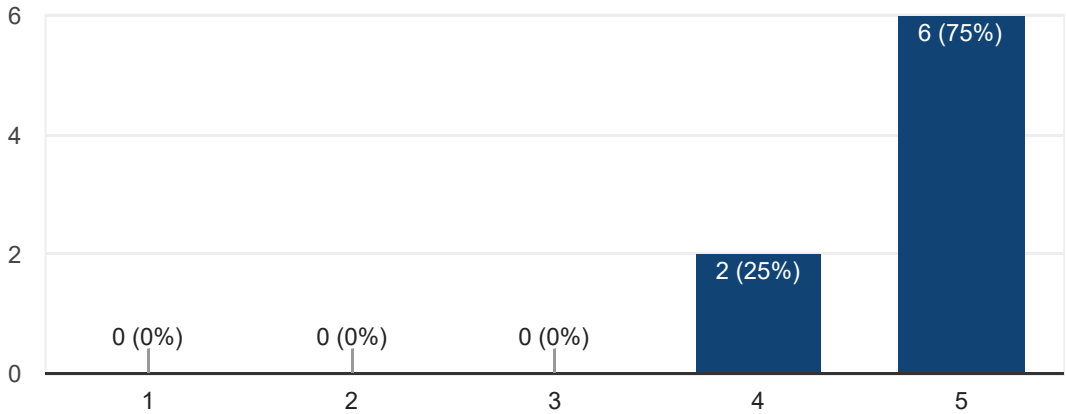
Your opinion about the effectiveness of the transnational collaboration (where there were shared tasks) and participation in activities?

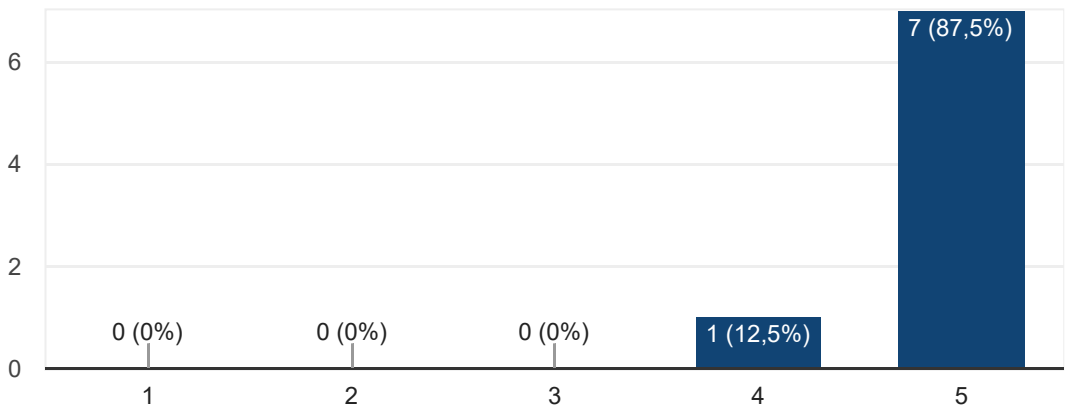
