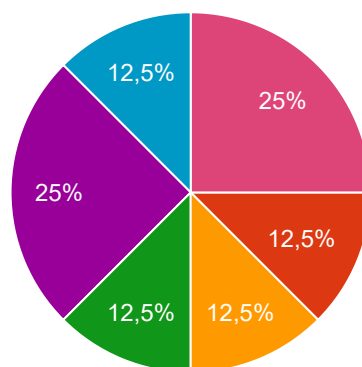

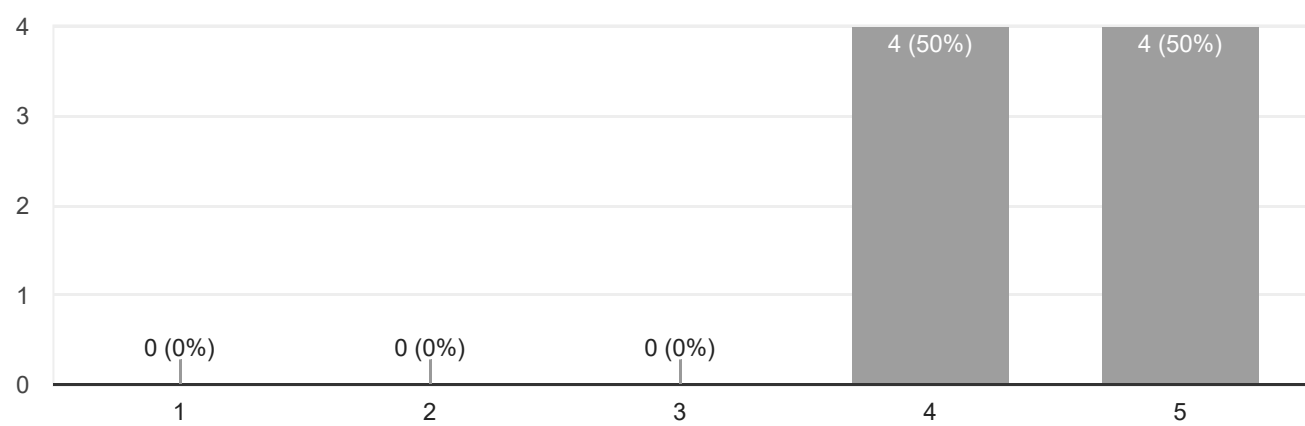

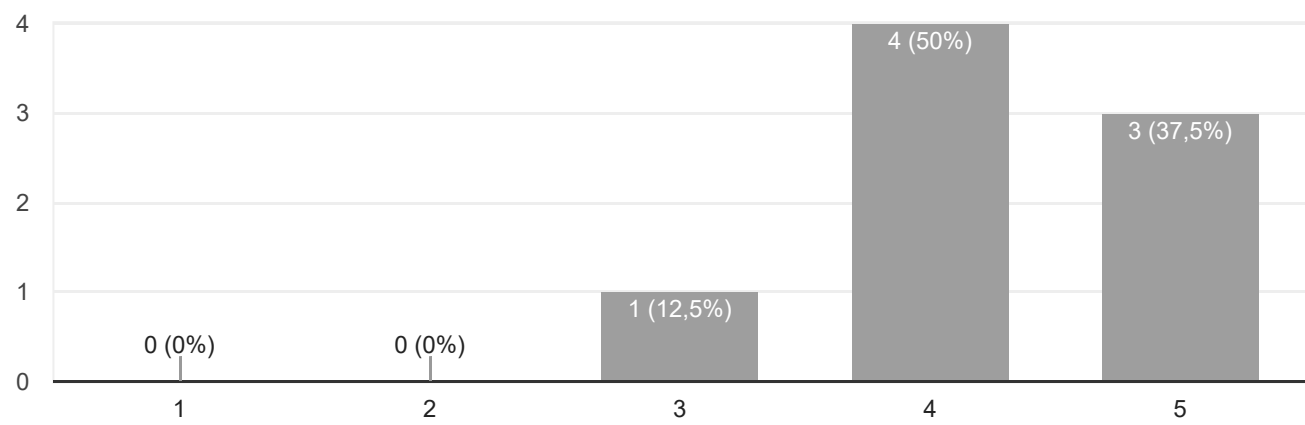
Appropriate definition of aims and objectives planned for the meeting?

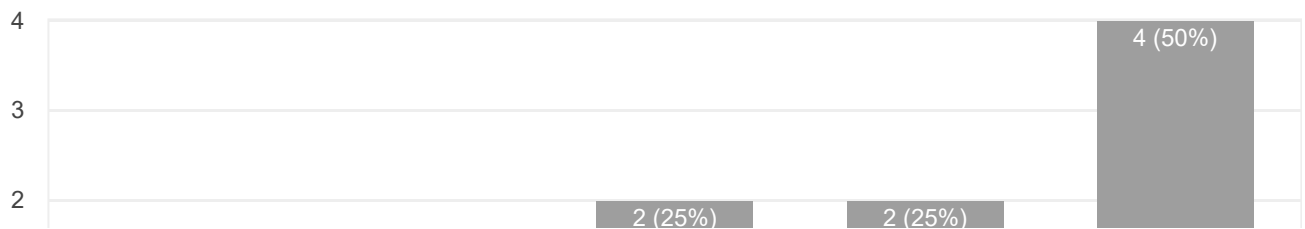
Realistic timetable?

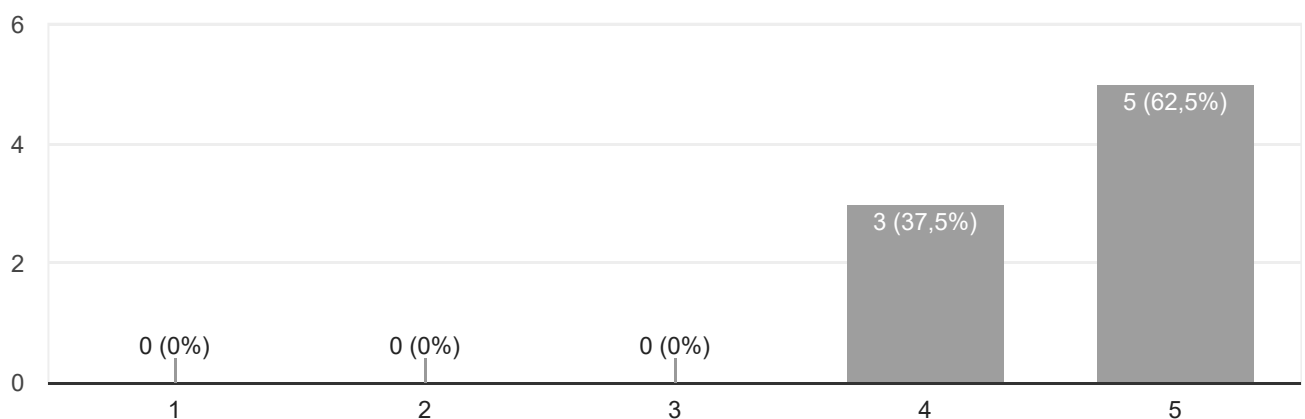
On a personal level, I never really understood who was who in the Italian team! Various friendly people appeared at meals, but I didn't really understand how they fitted into the project

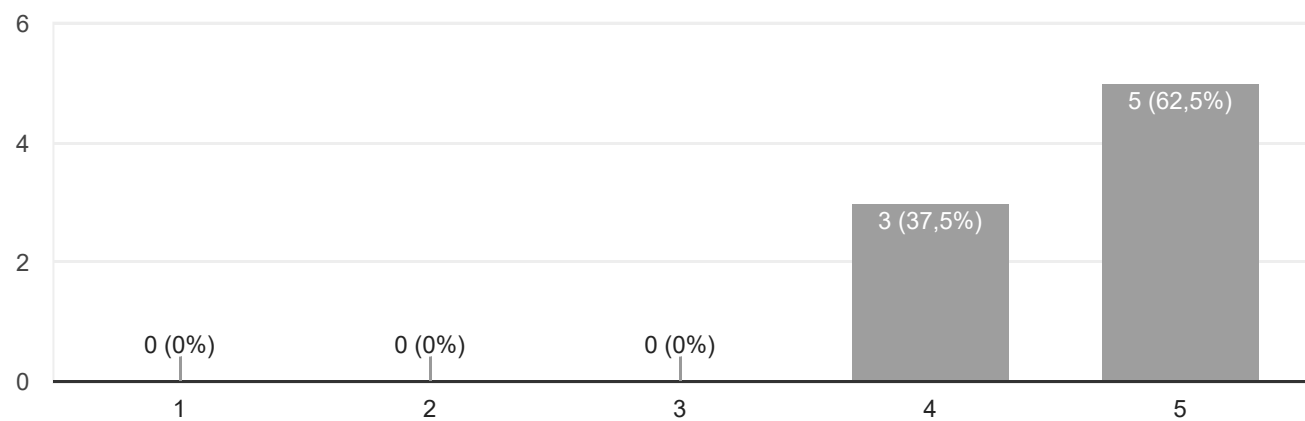

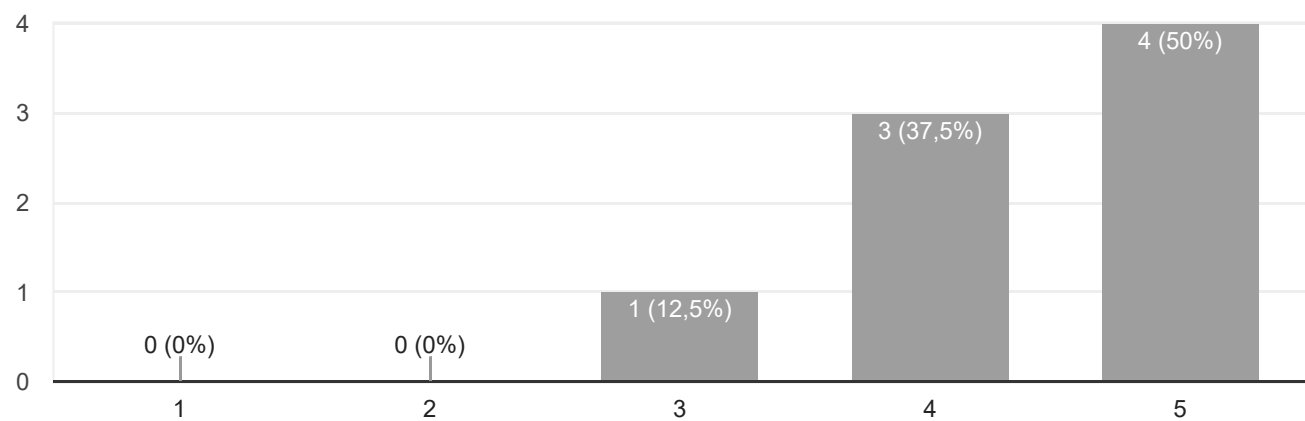
The meeting venue?

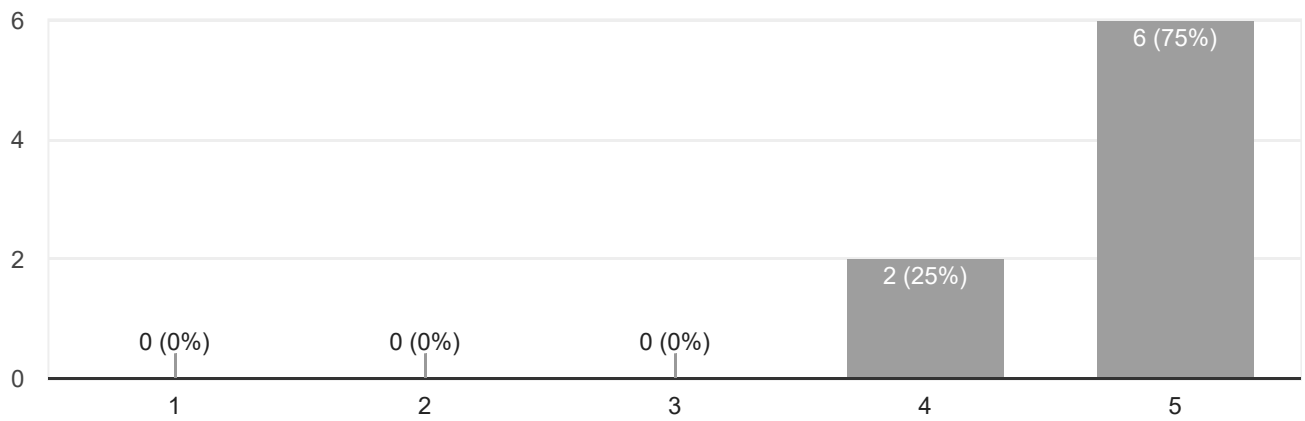

The hotel had plenty of hot water, always important. Being British I would have loved a kettle....

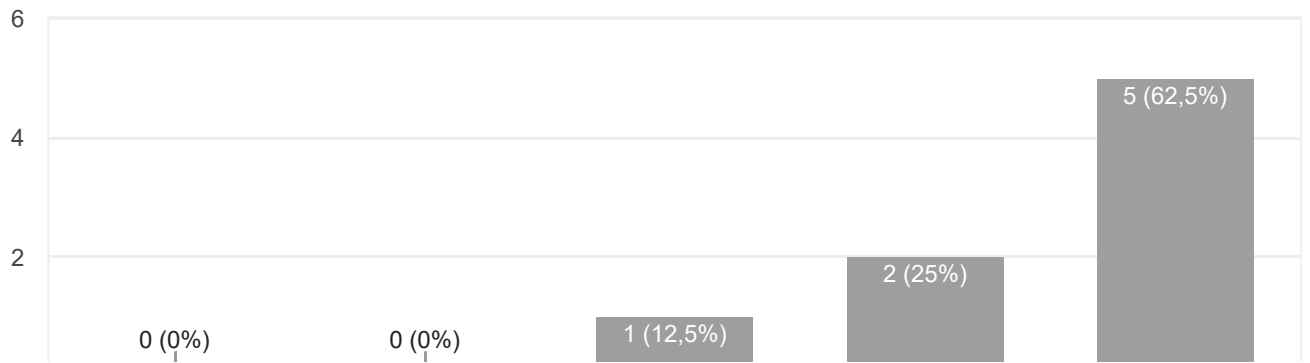
I really liked both Vasto as an accommodation base and the school in Scerni, probably unique for its training winery and agricultural museum

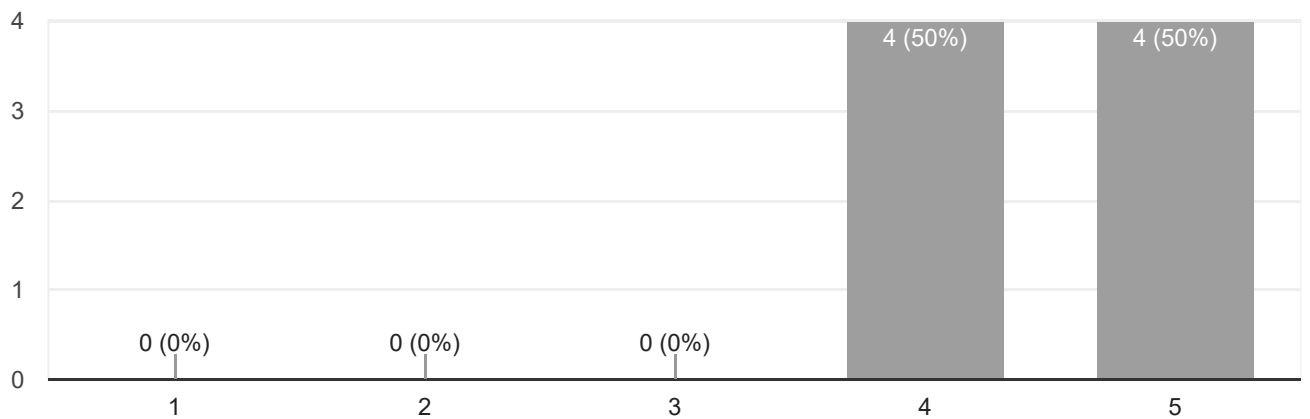
Achievement of aims and objectives planned for the meeting?

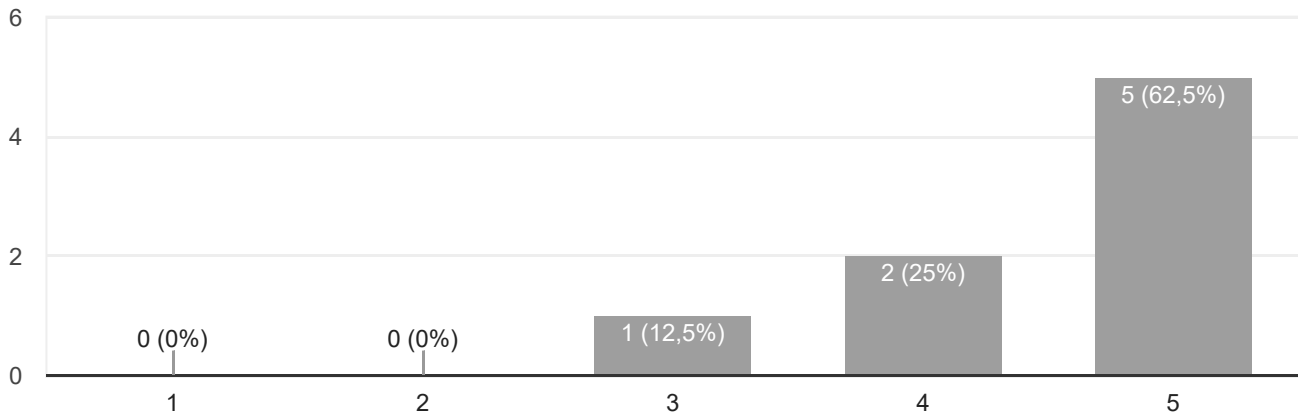

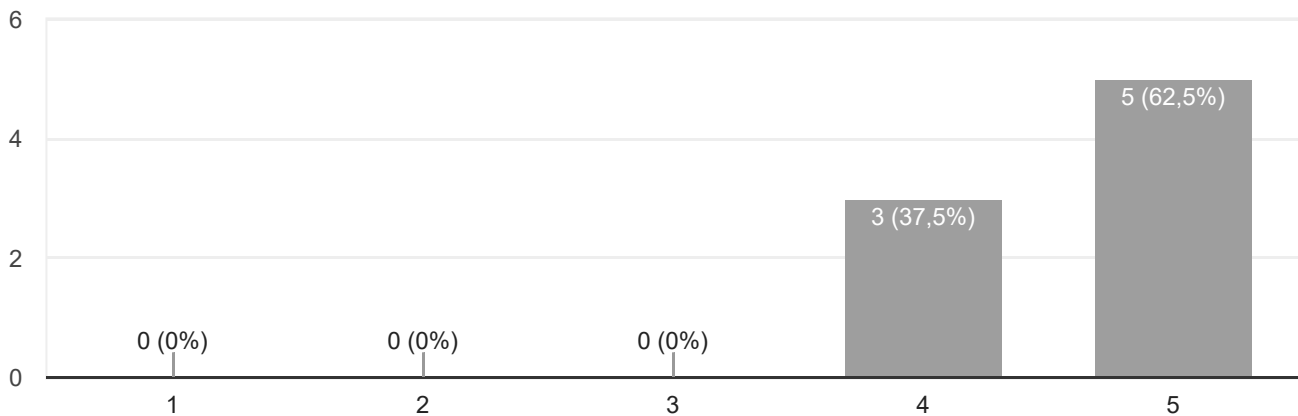
Your opinion about the effectiveness of the transnational collaboration (where there were shared tasks) and participation in activities?

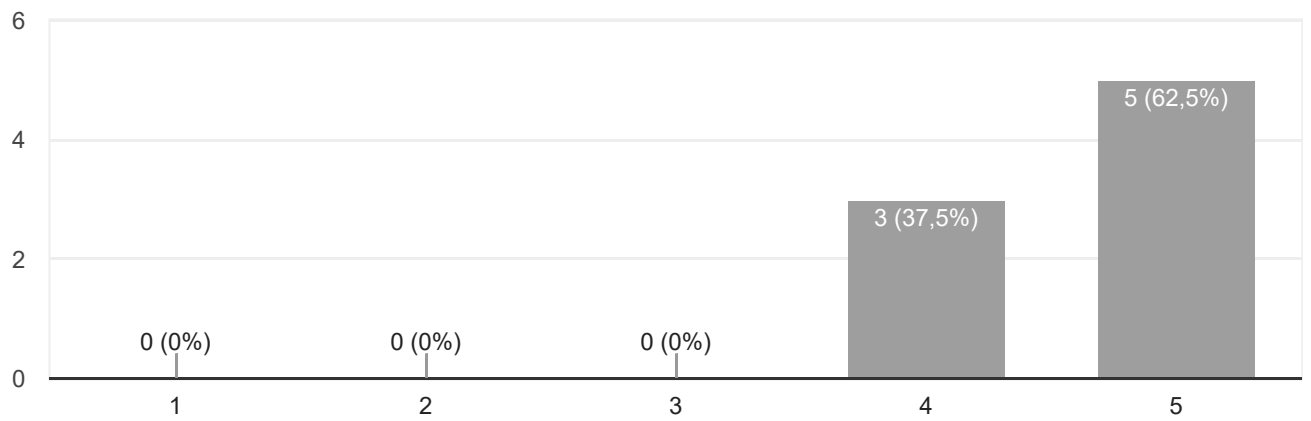
Partners had the opportunity to contribute with their own expertise?

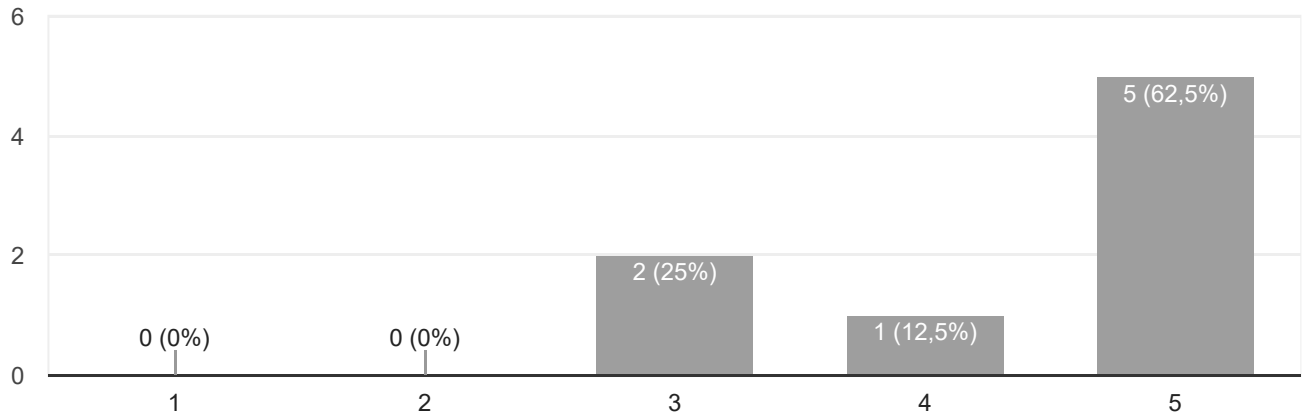


Was there active listening and cooperation? (coordinator to partner, partner to partner)

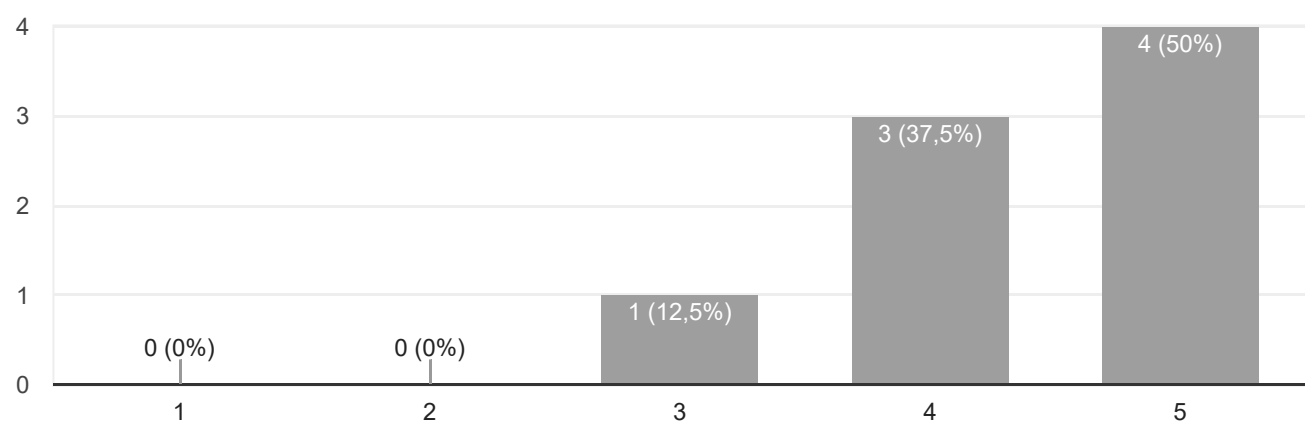

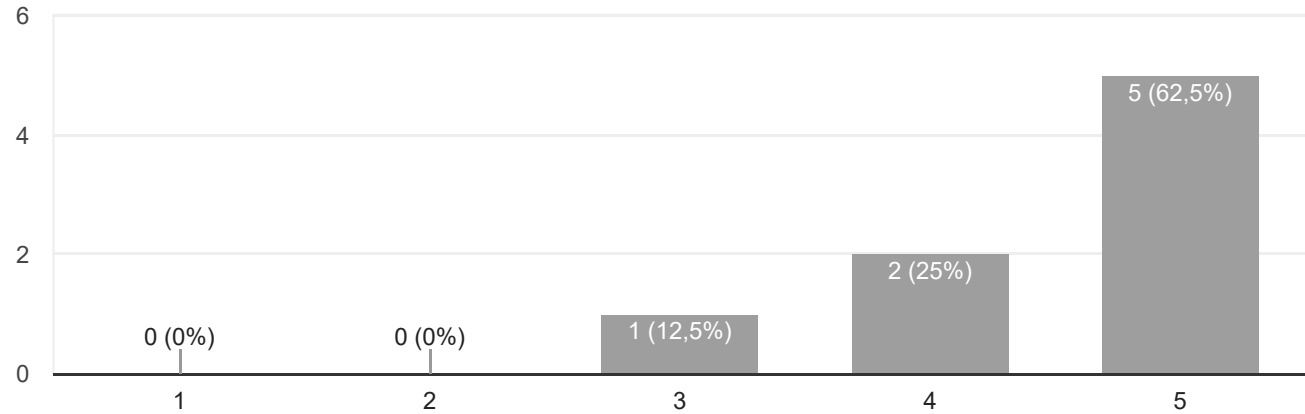
